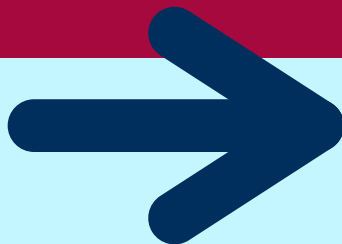

FAST FACTS

- The Census Bureau is committed to keeping your information confidential, private and secure. By law, individual-level census information cannot and will not be shared with any agency.
- Items like name, gender, age, birthday, race/ethnicity, relationship to head-of-household, owner or renter and phone number are asked on the Census. The Census will not ask about citizenship or immigration status.
- Census forms are filled out by household. Everyone living at the address matters and everyone needs to be counted, including children.
- You can respond online using the unique Census ID that will be mailed to you. If you don't have internet access, you can respond by phone or mail in March 2020.
- Being counted helps communities create jobs, provide housing, fund K-12 education, prepare for emergencies and build schools, roads, hospitals and libraries.
